Text Messaging Data: We will not share or sell your text messaging data or related personal information with third parties unless legally required.

4. Data Security:

We implement reasonable security measures to protect your personal information, using industry-standard security technologies. However, no transmission method or electronic storage is entirely secure.

5. Third-Party Services:

Our website may link to third-party sites or services. We are not responsible for their privacy practices or content and recommend that you review their privacy policies.

6. Children's Privacy:

Our website is not intended for children under 13. We do not knowingly collect personal data from children under this age. If we learn that we have inadvertently gathered such information, we will take steps to delete it.
